

Reggie Cheatham joined the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Emergency Management (OEM) within the Office of Solid Waste and Emergency Response (OSWER) as the acting director in July 2014. Prior to joining OEM, Cheatham served as the director of the Federal Facilities Restoration and Reuse Office within OSWER, the director of the EPA's Quality Staff in the Office of Environmental Information (OEI), the director of the Environmental Analysis Division in the Office of Information Analysis and Access within OEI, the deputy director of the Regional Support Division (Superfund Enforcement) in the Office of Site Remediation Enforcement within the Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA), the chief of the Chemical Industry Branch in the Office of Compliance within OECA, and as an environmental engineer for both the Federal Facilities Enforcement Office within OECA and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Enforcement Division within OSWER.



Prior to joining the EPA, Cheatham worked as a quality control/civil engineer in the construction industry and served in the United States Army. Cheatham holds a B.S. in civil engineering and an M.S. in environmental engineering from George Washington University.
