Chris Toms is Senior Analyst and Team Lead of the Risk and Operations Research branch of the U.S. Coast Guard Office of Performance Management and Assessment. His key areas of responsibility include performance analysis, risk assessment and decision support for Coast Guard strategic and annual performance planning processes. His specific initiatives include design and oversight of various program performance studies, development and execution of the Coast Guard National Maritime Strategic Risk Assessment, and serving as a subject matter expert in support of the Department of Homeland Security's National Risk Characterization.



Toms graduated from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy with a Bachelors of Science in Operations Research and Computer Analysis in May of 2005. He served two years in Kodiak, Alaska, as a department head aboard the Coast Guard Cutter STORIS and completed his active duty service at the Coast Guard's National Maritime Center, where he conducted work-studies that facilitated the centralization and improvement of the Coast Guard's Mariner Credentialing Program.
